



Announcement of The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences

Subject: A policy of not accepting all kinds of gifts from performing duties
(No Gift Policy) for the year 2026

The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences values and operates according to the government policy in preventing and suppressing corruption and misconduct to achieve the goals of driving the country's reform plan. This policy focuses on preventing corruption problems in Thailand and developing the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent and no conflict of interest in operation.

To strengthen the organizational culture and values of operating on the basis of responsibility with honesty and integrity, no conflict of interest from performing duties and create awareness of good work performance, SRU has established a policy of not accepting all kinds of gifts from performing duties (No Gift Policy) for the year 2025 as follows.

1. The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences administrators and staff refrain from receiving and giving all kinds of gifts and presents and any other benefits from performing duties that will result in corruption and misconduct both now and in the future.
2. The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences administrators and staff must not seek to obtain gifts, presents or any unlawful benefits or interests during/before/after performing duties.
3. The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences administrators and staff do not consent or connive with family members requesting or receiving all kinds of gifts, presents or any other benefits from those involved or interested in performing duties.
4. Expressions of congratulations, welcomes or condolences on various traditional occasions should be done by sending cards or books or using social media instead of giving things.
5. The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences administrators and staff have a responsibility to thoroughly inform outsiders of this policy.

Therefore, this announcement has been made for everyone's knowledge and strict observance.
